



Dr. Elsie Nguyen is an Assistant Professor in the Cardiothoracic Imaging Division, Joint Department of Medical Imaging, Peter Munk Cardiac Centre, Toronto General Hospital. She is fellowship trained in both cardiac (Stanford University) and chest imaging (University of British Columbia) and is level III trained for adult echocardiography. She is the only radiologist who reports echocardiograms in an academic centre in Canada. She is passionate about education for medical students, residents, observers, technologists, nurses and colleagues within medical imaging and beyond in cardiology, cardiovascular and thoracic surgery, respirology, haematology and anaesthesia. She is the Director of Undergraduate Education for Medical Imaging where she, along with help from an assembled national network of undergraduate educators, developed a National Medical Imaging Curriculum for medical students. She has been recognized with several teaching awards for excellence in teaching radiology residents and fellows.
