



Dr. Kibar Yared is currently Director of Echocardiography and Non-Invasive Cardiology at The Scarborough Hospital. He is also the Medical Director of the Cardio-Oncology clinic. Before moving to Toronto, Dr. Yared received his medical degree as well as Cardiology training at McGill University in Montreal. He subsequently completed an advanced Cardiac Imaging fellowship at the Massachusetts General Hospital – Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts. In Toronto, he was responsible for introducing advanced imaging techniques (including 3D TTE and TEE), updating the diagnostic equipment to meet the highest quality standards, and introducing standardized and structured reporting. The same experience has allowed him to incorporate cutting edge echocardiography into the work-up and management of patients in the Cardio-Oncology clinic, now actively following upwards of 250 patients. He has also spearheaded a cardiac CT program at the Scarborough Hospital. His research interests include Hypertrophic Cardiomyopathy, valvular heart disease and Cardio-Oncology.
