



**Dr. Lucy Roche** has a background in Paediatric Cardiology and is an Adult Congenital Cardiologist within the Peter Munk Cardiac Centre at Toronto General Hospital. She is particularly interested in the management of heart failure in patients with congenital heart disease, which is the primary cause of premature death in this population. In 2012, she established the ACHD-Heart failure clinic at the Toronto Congenital Cardiac Centre for Adults. This sub-specialty clinic now follows >150 patients. She is an Assistant Professor at the University of Toronto and her research interests while primarily focused on heart failure, transplant and mechanical support in ACHD, extend to many aspects of congenital heart disease in children and adults.

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
