



Dr. Mark Henderson was appointed Executive Vice President of Patient Services for Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC) and Regional Vice President for Cancer Care Ontario, Northwest Regional Cancer Program on September 4, 2012. Prior to that appointment, Dr. Henderson was the Medical Director of the Cardiovascular and Stroke Program at TBRHSC. He is an associate professor at the Northern Ontario School of Medicine. With 30 years clinical experience, Dr. Henderson is a leading interventional cardiologist who has served as an associate professor of medicine at the University of Toronto and Dalhousie medical schools and held a number of senior leadership positions in cardiac programs including: Director of the Coronary Care Unit, Toronto General Hospital and Victoria General Hospital (Halifax); Director of the Cardiac Catheterization Lab, Royal Columbian Hospital (Vancouver) and Victoria General Hospital; and Department Head of Cardiac Services, Royal Columbian Hospital. He also chaired the Medical Advisory Committee at the Royal Columbian Hospital for many years.

Dr. Henderson received his medical training at King's College Medical School, University of London, U.K. He moved to Canada in 1977 and continued his studies with the University of Toronto, completing his Internal Medicine and Cardiology training at Toronto General Hospital. His portfolio includes cardiac research published in leading national and international medical journals.
