She has opened a treatment room where we are able to administer IV and PO medications and blood transfusions, thereby providing in the moment interventions, potentially avoiding ER or hospital admission. Ms. Hemeon organizes and coordinates complex appointments and /or patients who travel great distances to come here. She also provides a name and a face for patients to call when they need to ask questions or update changes in their health. Suzanne liaisons directly between patients and doctors to provide timely exchange of information. Suzanne has a friendly face and she is a friend to many of the patients helping them relax and feel confident in the care that they receive here in the Peter Munk Cardiac Clinic.

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
